



Product Highlights: Hungry for every curve – The 718 Spyder

22/07/2020 The Porsche 718 Spyder is a particularly emotional and powerful model, sitting atop the 718 model series. Its pure character will appeal to sports car enthusiasts who delight in driving pleasure and appreciate a high level of agility and an intimate proximity to the centre of power while the breeze blows through their hair. The perfectly balanced mid-engine concept offers all this for open top purist drivers.

Unfiltered pleasure completely exhilarating

For the first time ever, the 718 Spyder shares a technical base with the 718 Cayman GT4. This includes the newly developed four-litre six-cylinder naturally aspirated engine, together with a six-speed manual transmission. Whilst the GT4 represents the entry-level GT road model from Porsche, the Spyder offers the chance to hear the engine note unfiltered with the roof down.

Pure Performance

At the heart of the 718 Spyder is a four-litre six-cylinder boxer engine. The naturally aspirated engine is based on the same engine family as the turbo engines in the current 911 Carrera model series. The fascinating character of this naturally aspirated engine boasts the immediate response of a GT engine and the unparalleled boxer sound remains untouched.

Designed for purists

The third generation of the Spyder is a pure machine for driving pleasure with a lightweight convertible top. It continues the history of famous Roadsters like the Porsche 550 Spyder and the 718 RS 60 Spyder.

Open or closed, it thrills with a captivating silhouette. The roof is suitable for everyday use and can be stowed away under the boot lid in just a few steps.

Unlike the GT4, the 718 Spyder has a rear spoiler that comes up automatically at 120 km/h. Thanks to the functional diffuser, it is the first model in the Boxster family to generate aerodynamic downforce at the rear axle.

Focused on driving dynamics

For the first time ever, the 718 Spyder also benefits from the high-performance GT chassis of the 718 Cayman GT4. With its superior cornering dynamics, it provides an emotional driving experience. Its further refined lightweight spring-strut front and rear axles make use of racing technologies.

The Porsche Active Suspension Management damping system with 30 mm lower suspension drops the centre of gravity and improves lateral dynamics potential. The Porsche Stability Management (PSM) operates with even greater sensitivity and precision but can optionally also be deactivated in two steps.

Porsche Torque Vectoring (PTV) with mechanical rear differential lock further enhances the longitudinal and lateral dynamics, cornering performance and driving pleasure.

At the race track drivers can hone their skills with the Porsche Track Precision App, which can be displayed directly on the car's screen using Apple CarPlay® and operated via the Porsche Communication Management (PCM) system.
